

# Things To Do With Your Student

*Fun Ideas To Fill Your Time*

1. **PICNICS:** You might make a customary picnic lunch while asking your student to share customary food or their favorite picnic dish.
2. **BAKING:** American kids grow up knowing how to make cookies and cakes but, most likely, your student does not. Teach them how to make your favorite treat or ask them to teach you how to make theirs!
3. **COOKING:** Ask your student if they will show you how to make a typical dish from their country. Show your student how to make your favorite family recipe!

9. **COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES:** Are always interesting. Ask your student if they want to participate in the community activities you may already be doing. Invite them to a Little League game, community playhouse, religious service, etc.
10. **MODEL HOMES:** A fun way to learn about American homes and cultures. Most host families live close enough to a model home. Ask your student if they would like to go and visit one with you.
